I will also send out the form to the Chapter Presidents to share with their Chapter Treasurers. **Make sure the form gets sent to Brenda**Campbell even if you pay the dues online. IC Dues must be paid by May 1st of 2026 in order for a chapter to be considered in "good standing" and receive voting privileges at IC Convention. It will help our incoming President, Stephanie Hess, out immensely if these dues are paid by January. This will mean that the first Credentialing Report she receives will be easy to confirm.

TAX FACTS

More Good News! Filing the Tax Fact forms can now be done electronically. Chapters and Councils must file the Tax Fact Form by September 15, 2025 to maintain our 501(c)4 notfor-profit status with the IRS. All the needed information is on the ESA Website. Click on Member Center and then look to the left for Treasurer Info. A drop down menu will appear. Choose Tax Facts and use that information to complete this task. Tax Facts forms are submitted to ESAMC—not the IC Treasurer.

ST. JUDE WALK 2025




